Ken S. Rosenthal, Ph.D. received his B.S. in Chemistry from the University of Delaware, his M.A. and Ph.D. in Biochemistry from the University of Illinois, and was an American Cancer Society post-doctoral fellow with Jack Strominger at the Dana Farber Cancer Institute, Harvard Medical School.

Dr. Rosenthal has received funding from the N.I.H., the American Cancer Society, and the Pharmaceutical and Biotech Industry for the development and study of immune-modulators, antibacterial and antiviral drugs; prophylactic and therapeutic vaccines for viruses, cancer and autoimmune diseases; as well as studies of the mechanisms of pathogenesis of herpes simplex virus. With Dr. Dan Zimmerman of CEL-SCI, he is a co-holder of patents for LEAPS anti-herpes simplex virus vaccines and has developed LEAPS vaccines to treat breast cancer and autoimmune diseases.

He is editor and a primary author of *MEDICAL MICROBIOLOGY*, 1st through 8th editions, and the 9th edition will be published in March. He is also the author of *Rapid Reviews of Microbiology and Immunology* 1st through 3rd editions (2010), *REVIEW OF MEDICAL MICROBIOLOGY* (2005), and *MEDICAL MICROBIOLOGY AND IMMUNOLOGY FLASH CARDS*, (2005, 2009, 2017).

At NEOMED, KSR was a Master Teacher of the NEOMED Master Teacher's Guild. His medical students chose him as Hooder (2011, 2012, 2014) and M2 Teacher of the Year, 2015 and for the Gender Equity Award, 2012. His pharmacy students chose him as Phi Lambda Sigma Honorary Member, 2015. He also received the Liebelt-Wheeler Faculty Excellence Award (2013) from NEOMED. KSR was the founding director of the microbiology and immunology course at the Herbert Wertheim COM at FIU and involved in the development of the Roseman University COM as Professor and Director of Microbiology and Immunology. He is the primary developer of MEDCAMP, CAMPMED, DISCOVERMED and other pre-college science education programs delivered in Ohio and Las Vegas, NV.
